Fall, Winter & Spring WEATHER FORECAST:

Big Chills and a White Christmas Predicted for Lehigh Valley with "Colder Than Normal" Weather Ahead

Who's Right...Old Farmer's or New Forecasters?

We've always considered the folks at the *Old Farmer's Almanac* to be the super heroes of long-range weather forecasting. Statistically, their old-time techniques have proven to be 80 percent accurate since 1792...so we've based the forecasts shown here on their projections.

But to be fair, modern meteorologists are quick to discredit the Old Farmer's secret prognostication methods (based on magnetic sunspots, temperature trends and maybe Uncle Zeke's bunions). This year, weather scientists are focused on the El Nino effect—an oceanic warming trend that typically brings warmer winters to our region.

So who's right...New Forecasters or Old Farmer's? Only the future will tell. Our advice is to keep your heating system tuned-up and fuel in the tank. Because rather than taking a chance on winter to be mild or wild, a cozy home is always your best bet!

OCTOBER

Memories of summer warmth linger on in the first half of October with temperatures well above average until mid-month rains cool things down to start the leafy transformation from green to a quiet riot of brilliant autumnal colors across our Lehigh Valley. Fall Foliage promises to be a brilliant show this year but may be cut short by heavy rains throughout Week 3...but keep those spirits up because Halloween promises to be clear and bewitchingly warm!

NOVEMBER

Nothing too spooky to report this month with temps a mere 1-degree F. below normal and rainfall absolutely average at 3.5 inches. A few ho-hum showers maintain the mediocrity until around the 14th or 15th when real cold kicks in. Count on snow flurries for Thanksgiving on the 26th. The first sticking snowfall of an inch or so hits that weekend and colder nights chill out the month.

DECEMBER

Shivery days and nights will be the norm during this holiday month with the mercury dropping 3-degrees F. below average. JANUARY

It may be a hot election year, but 2016 starts out cold as ice with a bone-chilling 3-degrees F. below average. Week 2 brings snow showers and low-teen temps and it's downhill from there as Week 3 hits single-digits with snowflakes a-flurrying until around the 27th when, for some mysterious reason*, the mercury climbs into the comparatively balmy high-thirties degree range. *Could it be all that political hot air?

FEBRUARY

Lovers' month won't be too "heart" to take with temps 2-degrees F. above average. But beware of that love triangle of ice, rain and snow precipitation dubbed by TV weather people as "A Wintry Mix." The sloppy stuff will pelt the Valley on and off for most of the first two weeks until Valentine's Day (on Sunday this year, guys) ushers in a 48-hour break of clear skies. Brisk-but-bearable wind chilled days and frigid nights take us to 2016's Leap Day on the 29th.

MARCH

Mother Nature won't get the memo about starting that Spring Thing in March this year. 2-degrees F. colder than average is predicted with snow showers hitting intermittently for three out of four weeks. APRIL

C'mon Spring...you can do it! April dips her veil a bit with temps slightly warmer than average. Okay, maybe it's not as steamy as we'd like after our big chill but it's enough to bring the crocuses peeking through the winter-worn earth. Not even a late "onion snow" is forecast! An abundance of seasonal showers with tolerably cool weather welcome what promises to be warmer-than-usual May and June weather here in our beautiful Lehigh Valley!
