During These Times of Lower Energy Prices: Enjoy the Ride

Our nation's historic energy revolution continues at full steam and consumers nationwide are cheering it on with more money in their pockets due to lower fuel prices and more confidence in a sustained future of American energy independence.

And if you should happen to drive along Stefko Boulevard in Bethlehem, don't worry about those chants of "U...S...A!! U...S...A!!" reverberating against your car windows. It's just everyone here in the Deiter Family leading those cheers for the most customer-friendly heating oil and propane prices we've seen in a long, long time.

"U.S. crude oil inventories remain near levels not seen for this time of year in at least the last 80 years."

Abundant domestic oil supplies are accompanied by reports that the global oil price drop may last for the next couple of decades. According to many authorities, including highly-respected economist Frank Wolak, Professor of Commodity Price Studies at Stanford University, new access technologies and oilfield discoveries—and the declining market role of OPEC (sorry guys...hope you didn't spend it all on Lamborghinis)—are driving this new petrofuel paradigm. The following excerpt from the recent Stanford Report speaks volumes about the sustainability 98526 of lower prices for heating oil, and its co-product generated in the refining process, propane.

"Global oil prices may stay low for the next 10 or 20 years, according to Stanford economist Frank Wolak... the primary reasons for continuing low prices include the slowing demand for oil in the industrialized world and ever-advancing technological change in the extraction and use of oil."

With heating oil prices at their current low levels and all indications that they will stay in this range for the foreseeable future, the siren song of cheap natural gas is starting to ring a bit hollow. Pardon my soap box here, but given this current turn of energy events I salute the wisdom and tenacity of you folks who are not falling for the natural gas fairy tale of cheaper prices happily ever after. Yes, some homes and businesses shelled out up to \$10,000 or more for new equipment, line connections and other costs required to switch to natural gas heat. It may have made sense when oil was over \$100 a barrel. But now it is half that and oil heat is progressively nearing closer to cost parity with natural gas. Plus, here's the dirty little supply/demand secret that the natural gas providers prefer that consumers do not learn. Domestic natural gas supplies are being sucked up at record rates by the electric utilities for power generation. Unprecedented additional supply pressures will soon be impacted by a new phenomenon: natural gas exports! Prices for natural gas in Europe and Asia are many times higher than they are in the U.S. For the past several years, billions in investment have gone into building new Gulf coast exporting terminals for LNG or



liquid natural gas—the highly-transportable compressed form of natural gas. And the transoceanic LNG tankers are getting lined up to ship a LOT of North America's natural gas to the highest global bidders...driving down domestic supply and upping costs for America's natural gas customers.

"The United States is on the verge of exporting its first major shipment of liquefied natural gas later this year or in early 2016, despite being a net importer of gas. That's because it's more profitable to sell gas offshore to foreign countries than to sell domestically. So, perversely, we can buy cheap natural gas from places like Canada, while at the same time exporting the same thing at higher prices, in liquefied form, since we have the ability to do so via ocean-going tankers."





Deiter Service Team Trains to Help Protect In-Home Seniors through Gatekeepers Program

Thousands of older adults throughout our Lehigh Valley community are living alone and at daily risk from in-home accidents, neglect or other circumstances which could impact their health, safety or independence.


The Lehigh Valley Gatekeepers Program is a collective community approach to connecting at-risk older adults to appropriate services to keep them living safely. Because many seniors live alone, or have little or no contact with others, their needs can go unnoticed. Gatekeepers are non-traditional referral sources who come into contact with seniors through their work. They are trained 267947 to recognize warning signs that help may be needed, obtain proper information and report their concerns to the Gatekeepers Program.

In Deiter Bros.' line of work, we are in hundreds of homes every week providing indoor comfort technical services. We see the Gatekeepers program as a great way to help protect seniors, so our entire service team recently took the certification training necessary to become a Gatekeepers Trained Organization (GTO). It was conducted in our classroom here at Deiter Bros.' Bethlehem headquarters by Amy Angelo through the social services network of the Diocese of Allentown.

Our service technicians are now aware of the many red flags which may indicate a senior's need for help, reporting protocols, and each is equipped with an anonymous ID number which is used to make referrals to the Gatekeepers Intake Line. The Area Agency on Aging follows up on each referral within 72 hours. If the person is in need, he or 3487 she will be connected to appropriate services.

We are proud to be able to help protect the senior population here in our home community, and thankful for programs like Lehigh Valley Gatekeepers which empower us all to help each other. After all, isn't that





s electric rates rise, heating oil prices drop and natural gas utilities scramble to replace aging gas lines, more homeowners are wondering what's the best value for their home heating. 

Deiter Bros. Fleet Continues Conversion to Clean-Burning Propane Power

To reduce fuel costs and do our part for a cleaner environment, we are in the process of converting Deiter Bros.' fleet of fuel delivery and service vehicles over to propane power. The latest addition is the new propane delivery truck shown here. (Gerry Weslowski, Propane Div. Manager in the cab and yours truly on the right.) Compared to gasoline, propane (also known as Liquid Petroleum Gas or LPG) yields 12% less carbon dioxide, 20% less nitrous oxide, and as much as 60% less carbon monoxide. What amazes me is how QUIET AND CLEAN a big propane powered engine is! All my working life has been around diesel 2593 engines. When I started up this newest delivery addition to our fleet, I didn't think the engine was even running. When you see any of Deiter Bros. fleet buzzing around your neighborhood, give us a wave!
